Montana Delegates to the 2016 Democratic National Convention

The Montana Democratic Party State Convention wrapped up activities Saturday night with the election of 21 delegates – 10 for Hillary Clinton and 11 for Bernie Sanders – who will represent the state and Democratic voters well July 25 – July 28.

"After a great day on Friday discussing the issues and values that we (Montana Democrats) uphold, it was so inspiring to watch the way delegates from all over the state put those words into action by selecting a diverse group of individuals who will represent us in Philadelphia," said Nancy Keenan, executive director of the Montana Democratic Party.
